Pastor Beatrice Katshunga shared the vision and goals for the upcoming year. Prayer Conferences Johannesburg & Lubumbashi

Lubumbashi Prayer Conference

On 28 October 2025, we held our second KGF Lubumbashi Prayer Conference under the theme Do Not Remain Silent Until Jerusalem Is Restored based on Isaiah 62:6-7. It was a time of spiritual renewal and powerful teaching for all who attended. Led by Pastor Jolie Luzolo, the conference encouraged participants to deepen their commitment to prayer and embrace their responsibility as intercessors to stand in the gap. Attendees testified to experiencing a renewed passion for prayer, stronger spiritual discipline, and a greater understanding of sacrifice and perseverance in ministry. Many intercessors left equipped and empowered to serve with greater effectiveness and dedication which was evident in the growing culture of prayer within the Katuba parish, the church where the KGF conference was held.



Johannesburg Prayer Conference



KGF Johannesburg hosted a Prayer Conference under the theme Possessing The Gates Through Intercession, grounded on Genesis 22:17 on 19 June - 20 June 2026. Led by Pastor Omer Ngoyi and founder, Pastor Beatrice Katshunga, the conference brought together believers with a shared hunger to grow in prayer, intercession and spiritual maturity and allowed attendees to experience spiritual renewal, healing and deep encounters with God. The conference concluded

with a renewed commitment among attendees to live lives of consistent prayer and intercession. Attendees felt encouraged to become intercessors in their own homes, realising that every household needs someone who stands in prayer. Members testified of feeling challenged and inspired to grow deeper in prayer as they used the conference as an opportunity to reflect on their prayer lives and learn what it means to be an intercessor and a watchman.

Intercessors Ministry Updates

During the first quarter, the intercession team met a total of twenty-two times, 11 in-person meetings and 11 online meetings. Six new members have joined the team and completed training with Pastor Beatrice Katshunga. In this first semester, the intercessors were exhorted to pursue holiness, humility, spiritual focus and complete dependence on the Holy Spirit in prayer. Emphasis was placed on praying with pure hearts, remaining spiritually alert and seeking strength from God to persevere faithfully in intercession. Prayer points included spiritual renewal, discernment to hear and see clearly in the Spirit, strength for church leaders and intercessors, peace over South Africa and the success of upcoming church gatherings and outreach initiatives.

Young Warriors & Teen Intercessors

The Young Warriors and Teen Intercessors classes were actively engaged this past semester, with three impactful lessons focused on understanding prayer. The first class welcomed 21 Young Warriors and 15 Teen Intercessors and began with a fun “Get to Know Me” game session. The groups were then divided with the Young Warriors receiving an introductory teaching on prayer from Teacher Jael, focusing on attentiveness during prayer and learning to hear God’s voice.

The Teen Intercessors participated in an open discussion led by Teacher Angelah where they reflected on their spiritual journeys, prayer lives, and topics they hoped to explore further in their understanding of prayer. The following two lessons centered around the theme “What is Prayer?”. The second session adopted a Q&A format allowing for both groups to ask questions and deepen their understanding of prayer through meaningful discussion with Teacher Angelah and Teacher Lydia. The third session featured a debate format for the Teen Intercessors where they explored and discussed



prayer-related topics guided by Teacher Jael, while the Young Warriors enjoyed interactive games and activities led by Teacher Lydia. A notable highlight in the Young Warriors calendar in the first semester was the third edition of the GRC Sunday School Fast & Prayer day held under the theme You are the light of the world. A town built on a hill cannot be hidden on 6 June 2026. Our principal, Angelah Tshala and Young Warrior teacher, Jael Mbay, led a one hour session where children received teachings on the Presence of God and were given a framework on how to pray.
